We, through our consistent efforts try to spread awareness about these communities and the hardships they are facing. We help them become self-independent. We also support quality oriented research to promote the physical, social psychological and medical needs for the needy.

HOW DID WE START

As we look back on our Founder-President Dr. Mohan Kumar's 35 years of journey since 1986, we feel overwhelmed with gratitude. Dr. Mohan Kumar (former employee of Indian Overseas Bank and now a musician) started his social work helping the needy at his own expense, he has an ambitious dream to ensure happier childhoods for India's children. He started a school in the name "St.Antony's Convent" and provided top class education facilities to the marginalized children in rural Bangalore catering to about 950 children, the school does its best in reaching out to marginalized communities. The school was providing quality education; support services and raises awareness among the family members about child education. In the Year 2000, Dr. Mohan handed over his school to someone due to bad health & continued his social work through an association he created under Society Act named "Karnataka Women & Children's Association" in the year 1996. Later, he registered the NGO under Trust Act by "New Might Grace Charitable Trust" on November 7, 2009 with like-minded members & they continued the social work together helping the needy through their new organisation. We've grown with new ideas of Dr. Mohan Kumar, Mr. Kishore along with his team who play an important role in enabling women and children community especially persons who are blind, destitute, physically handicapped, leprosy ridden & old age persons etc., to access the resources available to the society to unleash their inherent though often hidden potential through a holistic approach. We are planning to build a network with organizations working in the women and children sector especially the above said to come together with this organization in providing the necessary assistance to people.
