New Mighty Grace Charitable Trust is dedicatedly working to provide a good platform for women, children, senior citizens and those who are blind, destitute, physically handicapped. We aim to provide them the necessary resources and support in the form of Tailoring, embroidery, counselling services, education, educational support, wheelchair assistance, guidance for vocational education, job placement, physiotherapy required for their holistic development.

We, through our consistent efforts try to spread awareness about these communities and the hardships they are facing. We help them become self-independent. We also support quality oriented research to promote the physical, social psychological and medical needs for the needy.

HOW DID WE START

As we look back on our Founder-President Dr. Mohan Kumar's 35 years of journey since 1986, we feel overwhelmed with gratitude. Dr. Mohan Kumar (former employee of Indian Overseas Bank and now a musician) started his social work helping the needy at his own expense, he has an ambitious dream to ensure happier childhoods for India's children. He started a school in the name "St.Antony's Convent" and provided top class education facilities to the marginalized children in rural Bangalore catering to about 950 children, the school does its best in reaching out to marginalized communities. The school was providing quality education; support services and raises awareness among the family members about child education. In the Year 2000, Dr. Mohan handed over his school to someone due to bad health & continued his social work through an association he created under Society Act named "Karnataka Women & Children's Association" in the year 1996. Later, he registered the NGO under Trust Act by "New Might Grace Charitable Trust" on November 7, 2009 with like-minded members & they continued the social work together helping the needy through their new organisation. We've grown with new ideas of Dr. Mohan Kumar, Mr. Kishore along with his team who play an important role in enabling women and children community especially persons who are blind, destitute, physically handicapped, leprosy ridden & old age persons etc., to access the resources available to the society to unleash their inherent though often hidden potential through a holistic approach. We are planning to build a network with organizations working in the women and children sector especially the above said to come together with this organization in providing the necessary assistance to people.


Jai Kiran Trustee



EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION



1.3 Million People live in slums in Bangalore. Out of these, there are **0.4 million** children under the age of 6 living in slums and labor camps. As you drive down almost any road in Bangalore, you will see a construction site and right there, in the middle of the sand, gravel and machines you are likely to see small children playing. The population of the migrant workers in Bangalore is growing daily. The families live in 'blue tents' with no access to running water, electricity or sanitation.

Our organisation works for the betterment of children from less privileged backgrounds by providing them with a well-rounded education that enables them to be at par with other middle and upper-class children. We are in the process

of opening more learning centers, our centers follow a structured program to educate children from the slums. Since these center are strategically located near

slum neighborhood, it makes it very easy for the mothers to walk their children to the learning center each morning.



New Mighty Grace Charitable Trust follows a kindergarten program designed to give underprivileged children a good foundation in English language, arithmetic, general science, social and practical life skills at an early age of three years. Since these children would not get an opportunity to go to any early learning course due to economic difficulties we have been doing this completely free.



TUTION CENTER

A majority of school children in the slums of Bangalore come from homes where the parents are illiterate. Working in informal jobs, such as construction work, domestic work and street vending, children from these homes rarely go on to complete higher education and often fail their 10th grade public exams, so dropping out of the education system.

Lacking parental guidance these children often end up doing the same insecure work that their parents do, perpetuating the cycle of poverty.

For several years now NMGCT has runs 'after school tuition centres' which are attended by more than <u>60+ children</u>, aged between 6-16, 6 days a week, located within communal facilities in the slum.

Our aim is to expand the network of tuition centres to more slums in Bangalore, to keep slum children in the education system, enabling them to transform their future.



SUPPORTING THE POOR

We have distributed Food, Snacks, Cloths etc., regularly to many Poor Destitute, Construction workers, Construction workers Children etc., who live in Blue Tent houses in nearby Kalkere Slum, Horamavu Slum, Banjara Layout Slums, many have been benefited through this Programme.
